### IMPORTANT UPDATE FOR ALL PARENTS

Our school has been scheduled for an extensive building and renovation program. Unfortunately, the project managers have only awarded the contract to the builders in the last week. This is causing significant pressure at the school and requiring a number of last minute responses. Whilst most of the works are scheduled for the holidays, some will commence at the school next week. We must also entertain the likelihood that some works will need to be finalised in the first weeks of Term 1 2021 which may require some special arrangements.

Kaartdijin (B Block) will be handed over to the builders next week. Students and staff will be relocated to other areas of the school. Staff throughout the school are making preparations for the builders to empty their classrooms whilst the works are taking place. Affected areas include Kaartdijin B Block, Boodjar A Block, Moort C Block, library/computer room, admin area and assembly hall. This is all happening whilst we are in the midst of conducting the Graduation assembly, Awards assembly, camp and so on. During Week 10 the building manager has indicated that there will be NO building vehicles on site. This means that we can allow all access points to the school to remain open.

We seek assistance and understanding from parents at this difficult time with the following:

- Please ensure that students do not arrive on site before the designated time of 8.20 am.
- Please ensure that students are picked up promptly at the end of school and that after school arrangements are well understood.
- Avoid visiting the school before the first day for students on February 1 2021.
