NEW STATEWIDE POLICY - MOBILE PHONES

The new Student Mobile Phones in Public Schools policy bans students from using mobile phones from the time they enter school grounds to the conclusion of the school day. Kindergarten to Year 6 students are not permitted to have a mobile phone in their possession during the school day. In addition,

students must have smartwatches turned to aeroplane mode. The policy commences at the beginning of 2020. Our school will provide further information to parents before the commencement of school next year.
