The 2019 NAPLAN results indicated that whilst our school has a strength in Numeracy, our performance in several areas of English has room for improvement. To achieve better outcomes, next year we will commence gradually

implementing literacy programs that have proved to be successful in other Western Australian schools. We will also be timetabling a Literacy Block for all Year 1 to 6 classes as this model has contributed to our success in Numeracy. In 2020 the lunch break will be moved to 1pm so the Literacy and Numeracy Blocks can take place before lunch. Our school's start and finishing times, as well as the recess break, will remain unchanged.
