## M3 & M4 Herdsman Lake Wetlands Excursion

On Tuesday 28th October, M3 and M4 went on an excursion to explore one of our local wetlands.

We learnt about the importance of wetlands as the 'lungs' of the Earth, and how they keep nature healthy, protect us from floods, clean our water, and give homes to many living things. We sifted through soil and caught small creatures which we examined under microscopes.

We inspected hundreds of tiny creatures, met several local reptiles, and walked through the beautiful landscapes. It was a great place to visit and a beautiful day. Who knew that swamps were so important!





## B3 & B4 Perth Zoo Excursion

On Thursday 30th October the B3 and B4 classes set off for a full day adventure exploring the Perth Zoo. A sprinkle of rain didn't dampen students' excitement. Upon entry we were lucky enough to be entertained by the white cheeked gibbons in their new immersive habitat running, climbing and swinging above us on their rope pathways.

One of the highlights of the day was the Habitat Heroes lesson in the Discover centre specially booked to support our Talk for Writing and Reading units on Australian animal texts such as Possum Magic, Edward the Emu and How To Trap a Penguin.

An interactive map mat was used to match Australian animals to different climates, habitats and shelters. In small groups the students then visited the reptile and penguin exhibits filling out a survey finding clues to see if the animal habitat was well matched to its habitat needs.

The students learnt about animal conservation and how to help local wildlife, real world wildlife threats and even got to stroke a friendly bobtail lizard. Another highlight was listening to the Penguin keeper talk and seeing the penguins up close being feed.

It was wonderful to see so many bright and colourful bandannas around the school — a great reminder of our caring and compassionate community. Thank you for making a difference!

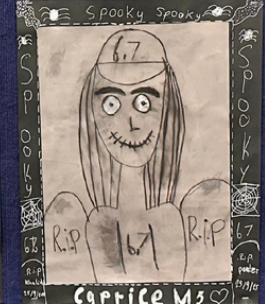
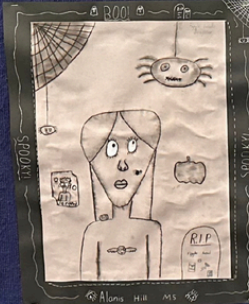
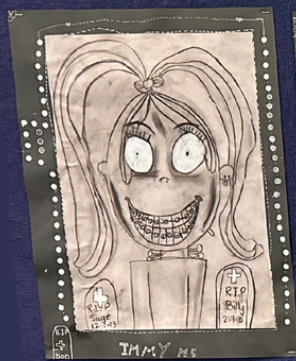
## Amazing Artwork
