NOTIFICATION OF SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2027

Financial support supplied by parents and carers plays a significant role in extending our school capacity to add value to the learning experiences of our students. This support is provided in the form of:

Beldon Primary School's Board has endorsed this schedule of contributions and charges for 2027 which aligns with the *School Education Regulations 2000* as part of the *School Education Act 1999*.

PART A – VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Voluntary Contributions are used towards the cost of resources used by students in the education program and represent an important revenue source. Whilst contributions are voluntary, the quality of the program in all curricular areas is enhanced when families contribute. Although payment for Voluntary Contributions is expected in term 1, if you would like to arrange a payment plan, please contact the Front Office to discuss options.

The total voluntary contribution sought per child is \$60.00.

PART B – ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE

These are items that a student requires to fully participate in learning activities. The list of items varies by student, and includes:

- Required by all students for use in lessons, e.g., stationery, calculator, etc.
- Recommended for all students, e.g., art shirt, tissues, etc.
- Required for selected students, e.g., musical instruments.

Some items, such as calculators and headphones, library bags can be used in successive years. Other items – e.g., pens, pencils, glue, may need to be replenished throughout the year. A list of recommended items (known as the "booklist") is provided for each child. Parents may purchase items from any retailer or use the school's nominated supplier, Campion Education.
