PUBLIC SCHOOL REVIEW

In 2018 the Department announced that all government schools will participate in a Public School Review. The reviews will provide assurance to the Minister, Director General and school communities that our schools are operating effectively and delivering high quality education to their students. The reviews will also provide valuable feedback to principals and their staff to help improve the performance of their schools. Each review will incorporate rigorous self-assessment, appropriate analysis of data, and sound judgments about performance strengths and weaknesses. All reviews will focus on those aspects of school performance defined in the research literature as being central to school effectiveness: that is, student achievement and progress; high quality teaching; strong school leadership; and a safe and supportive learning environment.

Beldon Primary School will be reviewed in Week 4 of Term Two. The review will provide

feedback to help us improve our school performance and refine our 2019 to 2021 Business Plan.
