## The Application Process

Scholarships are provided on a bi-annual basis.

There are 2 categories of scholarships:

1. Educational
2. Extra-curricula

There will be 5 x Educational Scholarships and 5 x Extra-Curricula Scholarships awarded twice per year. Each scholarship is up to the value of \$500.00 (maximum amount that can be applied for)

## Overview

One of the key goals of Friends With Dignity and Jeunesse Kids is to support children in need. Whilst we recognise that the range of needs is potentially quite broad, we are keen to provide practical support to children specifically affected by domestic and family violence. As such, there are 2 categories in which we are providing targeted support - educational and extra-curricula.

### Educational

The Educational category may include, but is not limited to, textbooks, stationary requirements, specialised equipment such as IT or Art supplies or Hospitality uniforms. It may include costs for excursions, camps, access to academic competitions, or school uniforms including shoes, ties and blazers. It may be provided for one item or several items within this category.

### Extra-Curricula

The Extra-curricula category may include, but is not limited to, sporting equipment, sport uniforms, tuition costs, training or transport costs. It may include equipment for music, the arts, or it may be for camps, tours, or to cover the costs of representative teams. It may also be used for sign up or registration fees for a sporting season, competition, debating, or some element of the arts. It may be provided for one item or several items within this category.

## The Application Process

- Applications can only be submitted by a person over 18 years of age.
- Applications must be completed by either:
  - the Parent or authorised Guardian of the child; or
  - an authorised Social Worker, GP, School Principal, Counsellor
- Applications must be co-signed by both the Parent / Guardian of the Child AND the Social Worker, GP, School Principal or Counsellor.
- Children must be between the ages of 5 and 18 years of age at date of application.
- Successful Applicants must provide Receipts with proof of purchase within seven (7) days of funds being paid for auditing purposes.
