

Dear Parents and Guardians

After consulting the current Department of Education COVID 19 guidelines, we have decided to go ahead with one Lapathon event for students from Pre-Primary to Year 6. The Lapathon will be occurring on **Friday 31 July**, with details as follows:

- Location Beldon Primary School oval
- Starting time of the Lapathon 1:40pm
- Duration of the event approx. 1 hour, with and anticipated finish time of 2:40pm.
- All students are to return to class following the completion of the event.

The P&C is kindly making arrangements for a sausage sizzle to occur at 1pm (school lunch break) on the day of the Lapathon. You will have received a sausage sizzle lunch order form for your child earlier this week with details for payment. We normally provide a sausage sizzle for parents and community members on the day of the event, however due to current COVID 19 guidelines, we are now inviting parent's/community members to pre-order either with their child's order form or on a separate form available from the front office. Parents will also be sent a link to access the form via connect to download, print and place in the school payment money boxes (located in each block). Due to stock ordering, please be advised that all orders will need to be received by Monday 27 July.

We have made arrangements for parents to have lunch with their children on the school oval from approx. 1pm to 1:30pm. If you would like to do so, you will need to collect your child from their classroom at the start of lunch time (1pm).

To address the current COVID-19 phase 4 guidelines, we ask that all parents adhere to the following guidelines:
